

About Main Facilities

Library :

The College has beautiful and spacious library. Library has a massive collection of more than 4000 books and it subscribes to 10 scientific periodicals and journals every year. Specifically library includes text books and reference books recommended by the Board of studies of the University. Library timing is 11.00 am to 5 p.m. Library can accommodate 50 students at a time and Reading Room is kept open from 5 p.m. 11 p.m. for examination preparation.

- Students is admitted to the library as well as in the reading room only on presentation of Library card and has to observe complete silence and obide by the rules of behaviour framed by the college from time to time in this regard.
- A special issue section is provided for issue of books for home reading. For reading at home a book can be issued for seven days. Classwise specific days are fixed for issuing books. Students has to fill in the demand slip on the previous days, programme of issuing book for home reading will be dispayed on the notice board. Student cab borrow only one book at time. If book is not returned within the time limit, the student has to pay penalty of Rs. 1 per day till the book is returned.
- Book in reading room can be issued only for using the book in the reading room only.
- Student should take no dues certificate from the Librarian befor 15th March. There after the prior permission from the principal will be required.
- Intimation of the loss of book should be given to the Librarian within two days. Five times the cost of the lost book will be recovered from the student.
- Before leaving the issuing counter, make sure that the book borrowed is in good and neat condition, thereafter no complaint will be listened by the Librarian.
- If Identity/Library card is lost, immediately ultimate to the Librarian. Library will not be responsible for the misuse of Identity card/Lib, card.

Gymkhana and Sport Facilities

Excellent arrangement have been made for games and sports. Due encourangement is given to sportment and atheletes.

Student's Grievance Cell

In addition, the college has modern educational equipments, like slide projector, overhead projector, and epidiascope projector. Computer laboratories have been set up separately. A Local Area Network with internet facilities has been formed. LCD Facility is available from 2008-09.

Course Structures

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.)

ELIGIBILITY :

Candidate who has passed Higher Secondary School Certificate examination of Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary examination or an equivalent examination of any other Statutory board or University with English and any three science subjects out of (i) Physics (ii) Chemistry (iii) Biology (iv) Maths (v) Geography shall be eligible for admission to the first year B.Sc. (Biotechnology) degree courses

- Candidate passing H.S.C. Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Higher Secondary Education or any equivalent examination with English, Maths and physics will be eligible for admission to F.Y.B.Sc. Computer Science Course. Candidate passing Govt. Diploma In computer Subject is also eligible to F.Y.B.Sc. Computer Course.
- While Selecting the combination of subjects at F.Y.B.Sc. level, the students should take into consideration admissible combinations of subjects at S.Y.B.Sc.

First Year B.Sc.

- The students joining F.Y.B.Sc. (Computer Science) have to choose four subjects from
1) Computer Science, 2) Mathematics, 3) Electronics, 4) Physics / Chemistry.
- The students joining F.Y.B.Sc. (Biotechnology) have to choose four subjects from
1) Biotechnology, 2) Botany, 3) Zoology, 4) Physics/Chemistry
- The students joining F.Y.B.Sc. (Microbiology) have to choose four subjects
1) Microbiology, 2) Botany, 3) Zoology, 4) Physics/Chemistry
- **Examination Pattern :-** There shall be a semester pattern of examination of 50 marks for each theory course comprising of external examination of 40 marks and continuous internal assessment of 10 marks. There shall be an annual pattern of examination of 100 marks for each practical course comprising of external examination of 80 marks and continuous internal assessment of 20 marks.

It is compulsory for students to appear all the tests / tutorials / assignments. If students fail to appear for internal examination, term will not be granted.

Besides these papers, students have to appear for a compulsory paper of "Environment Studies"

Second Year B.Sc.

A student shall offer three out of the four subjects offered by him at F.Y.B.Sc. In addition, he shall offer one language: English or Marathi Compulsory.

- The students joining S.Y.B.Sc. (Computer Science) Shall have Three Subjects of the following
1) Computer Science, 2) Mathematics, 3) Electronics
- The students joining S.Y.B.Sc. (Biotechnology) Shall have Three Subjects of the following:
1) Biotechnology, 2) Botany, 3) Zoology

Besides these papers, students have to appear for a compulsory paper of "General Knowledge."

- **Examination Pattern :-** There shall be a semester pattern of examination of 50 marks for each theory course comprising of external examination of 40 marks and continuous internal assessment of 10 marks. There shall be an annual pattern of examination of 100 marks for each practical course comprising of external examination of 80 marks and continuous internal assessment of 20 marks.

It is compulsory for students to appear all the tests / tutorials / assignments. If students fail to appear for internal examination, term will not be granted.

Third Year B.Sc.

The college provides following principal subjects at T. Y.B.Sc.

1) Computer Science, 2) Biotechnology, 3) Microbiology 4) Chemistry

Note : 1) The Students shall offer one of the three subjects offered by him at S.Y.B.Sc. as his principal subjects.

2) The Principal Subject shall have six theory papers of 50 marks in each semester and three practical papers of 100 marks each annually.

- **Examination Pattern :-** There shall be a semester pattern of examination of 50 marks for each theory course comprising of external examination of 40 marks and continuous internal assessment of 10 marks. There shall be an annual pattern of examination of 100 marks for each

practical course comprising of external examination of 80 marks and continuous internal assessment of 20 marks.

It is compulsory for students to appear all the tests / tutorials / assignments. If students fail to appear for internal examination, term will not be granted.

Admission Procedure

- ❖ Application for admission should be submitted in prescribed form. The applicant should fill the form carefully.
- ❖ Incomplete or incorrect form will not be accepted.
- ❖ For admission to F.Y. classes eligibility form, original marksheet and its true copy are necessary. Admission will not be confirmed unless eligibility is obtained from the N.M. University.
- ❖ The students of S. Y. & T.Y. classes should attach marksheet to the admission form the attested copy of previous examination.
- ❖ Students from other colleges within the jurisdiction of N.M. University, must produce T.C. at the time of admission in this college. Such a student will have to obtain written permission from University for the change of the college.
- ❖ Normally no change is allowed in the subject once offered by a student. However any change in the subject can be allowed by the authorities only on payment of fees of Rs. 25- The last date for allowing the changes in subject/faculty will be notified separately on the notice board.
- ❖ No student can claim right of admission to the college. The authorities can refuse admission to any student without giving any reason.

University Eligibility

- ❖ Every student seeking admission to any graduate or postgraduate course of North Maharashtra University for the first time is required to obtain eligibility from the University. Student has to apply in prescribed form and pay the required amount of fees to obtain eligibility.
- ❖ Following documents are required to be submitted alongwith the prescribed form:
1) Original Marksheet 2) Transfer Certificate
(For other University students/other Maharashtra state board students, following additional documents are required.)
3) Migration certificate. 4) Passing certificate. 5) Attendance certificate.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the student to see that his / her eligibility certificate and other certificates are secured by him/ her from the previous University & college and that they are produced to the college along with eligibility certificate form before specified date.
- ❖ College shall not be responsible for any consequences of non-grant of eligibility by the University.
- ❖ Students are advised to take note of notices from time to time.

Procedure for payment of Fees

1. All payments are to be made in college accounts office.

Terms and Attendance

1. 75% attendance of total number of days in a term is necessary to enable a students to be admitted to University examination.

2. A day's attendance means attendance at all lectures & particals prescribed in the college timetable for the class in which the student is studying.
3. Satisfactory attendance means attendance on all days on which college is functioning except when leave of absence has been provisionally granted by the principal

Disciplinary Rules

1. Students shall abide by all the general and special rules framed by the college authorities from time to time in regard to their conduct and studies.
2. Students, admitted to the college, are subject to the control of the authorities in regard to their conduct in college premises.
3. Students shall not remain absent for lectures and practical without proper cause and an application for leave of absence shall be submitted to the principal.
4. No student is will be allowed to make active part in the political activity, directly or indirectly, associated with anti-social movement or any activity with the aim of violence.
5. Students should not in any way disfigure the premises of the college building or tamper with the furniture, electric connection, laboratory apparatus, Computer Lab. etc.
6. Every student must obtain college identity card within a week from the date of admission.
7. Every student must have college identity card with him at all times in the college premises.
8. Students are strictly prohibited to smoke / consume drugs, narcotics, tobacco, gutkhas, in college premises. Not only this, but if a student, is found in possession of narcotics and druges, he will be liable for punishment under the mumbai Police Act. 1951.
9. Ragging and such similar activities are strictly prohibited. Breach of these and such other rules will make the students liable for expulsion from the college. Code of conduct for the principal

The Principal of the institution shall.

1. Endeavor to fulfil the vision, Mission and goals of the Sanstha's.
2. Promote all the staff members to update their knowledge by encouraging them to organize and participate in seminars, conferences, workshops, symposia, orientation and refresher courses.
3. Encourage the faculty to carry out research and publish their research papers / articles in reputed national, international journals, e-journals and books/volumes.
4. Take all necessary actions to maintain discipline on the campus.
5. Treat all faculty members, non-teaching staff, students and stakeholders on equal footing and not indulge in favoritisms.
6. Involve all the stakeholders in the development of the institution.
7. Promote the decentralization of power for the effective administration of the institution.

Code of conduct for Faculty :-

Every teaching non-teaching staff member shall.

1. Every teacher shall, at all times, maintain integrity, be devoted to duty and also be honest and impartial in his / her official dealings. A teacher shall, at all times, be well-mannered in his / her dealings with the management, with other members of staff, students and with members of the public.
2. Unless otherwise stated specifically in the terms of appointment, every teacher is a whole-time teacher of the institute and may be called upon to perform such duties as may be assigned to him / her by the competent authority beyond the scheduled working hours and on holidays and sundays.
3. Abide by the rules of dress code on the campus.
4. A teacher shall be required to maintain the scheduled hours of work during which he / she must be present at the place of his / her duty. No teacher shall be absent from duty without prior permission. Even during leave or vacation, with the prior permission of the competent authority whenever leaving the station, and teacher should inform the Principal in writing, through the concerned Head of the Department or the Principal directly.
5. Ensure the cleanliness, maintenance and proper utilization of equipment's, apparatus, classrooms and any material in the library, laboratory and on the campus of the institution.
6. Cooperate in the joint welfare of all the teachers and non-teaching staff.
7. Contribute to keep the campus of the institution tobacco-free, drug-free, pollution-free and plastic-free.
8. Be obliged to prohibit sexual harassment of a colleague and student on the campus of the institution.
9. No teacher shall take part in politics, or be associated with any political party or organization which takes part in political activity, nor shall subscribe, aid or assist in any manner any political movement or activity.

Code of conduct for students :

Every student admitted in this institution shall

1. Plan to arrive to class on time and to stay for the entire class period (or until dismissed) because random arrivals and exits are disrespectful and distracting.
2. Have 75% of attendance for the theory classes, practicals and tutorials.
3. Ragging is banned on the institute campus, Anyone found guilty of ragging and / or abetting ragging is liable to be punished as per the directive of the UGC and Govt. Any incident of ragging will be dealt with seriously. The culprits will be dismissed from the insitiute and a case will be filed with the local police authorities.
4. Students shall compulsorily wear the prescribed institute uniform on all working days except wednesdays. Uniform symbolizes unity and unifromity., not diversity. It also indicates equality and a sense of belonging to the institution Uniform provides a special identity. Hence it is a source of pride and responsibility, not liability. Parents are to see that the uniform and hsirstyle of their wards are in tune with modesty and dignity.
5. Appear for tests and examinations as per the time table of the university and the institution.
6. Strict silence must be observed in Redding room and Library.
7. Students are expected to spend their free time in the library. They should not loiter along the corridor or crowd along the passage.
8. Always carry with him/ her the identity card issued by the institution.
9. Read the notices put up on the notice boards of the institution regularly.
10. No indulge in any activity that will damage the property of the institution.
11. The institute prohibits political activities on the campus and forbids students from conducting and attending political meetings within the institute campus.
12. Contribute to keep the campus of the institution tobacco-free, drug-free, pollution-free and plastic-free.
13. Talking and other disruptive behaviors are not permitted while classes are in session.
14. Food and beverages are not permitted in computer labs, laboratories or classrooms.


MISSION OF OUR BOTH COLLEGES


